

# Southern Ocean to Top End by Private Jet

- Admire Uluru in the moments before sunrise, where thousands of coloured lights from the Field of Light installation give off an otherworldly glow.
- Enjoy a special experience at the Alice Springs Desert Park, surrounded by the majestic Red Centre landscapes.

#### Day 01: Melbourne, Kangaroo Island

Board your private jet this morning for your flight to Kangaroo Island. Upon arrival, learn about conservation efforts at the Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park and visit the Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery. Later enjoy a scenic tour of the island, including a visit to Seal Bay. **LD** Stay: Kangaroo Island, Aurora Ozone Hotel.

Day O2: Kangaroo Island, Port Augusta, Wilpena Pound After breakfast, board your private jet to Port Augusta. Here set off on a guided tour which includes a visit to the Wadlata Outback Centre. This afternoon, drive to the Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park and discover Wilpena Pound, a natural rock amphitheatre cradled within two mountain ranges. BD

Two nights: Wilpena Pound, Wilpena Pound Resort.

Day 03: Wilpena Pound This morning, explore the natural surrounds of Wilpena Pound by foot. At the geological site of Parachilna Gorge, keep an eye out for the endangered yellow-footed rock wallaby. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure, perhaps taking off on an optional scenic flight to see the region from the air. BLD

Day 04: Wilpena Pound, Uluru Journey back to Port Augusta to reboard your private jet. Today's flight to Uluru will be via the 'scenic route' with bird's-eye views of Wilpena Pound, the Marree Man, Lake Eyre, and of course around Uluru itself. Your Captain will ensure everyone on board gets to enjoy the spectacular sights. After landing transfer to your luxury resort hotel. BD Two Nights: Uluru, Sails in the Desert.

**Day 05: Uluru** At sunrise, experience the early morning glow of the Field of Light art installation. Later on, venture deeper into Kata Tjuta National Park. This evening, there is an option to indulge in a Sounds of Silence dinner under the stars (own expense). **B** 

Day O6: Uluru, Alice Springs Perhaps rise early again to see another sunrise over Uluru. After breakfast, board your private jet for your flight to Alice Springs, with aerial vistas of Kings Canyon and the surrounding Watarrka National Park. Arrive into 'The Alice' where you'll set off on a guided tour. Tonight, enjoy an Outback Bush BBQ dinner and show. BD

Stay: DoubleTree by Hilton Alice Springs.
